TENTATIVE MORPHO-PHONOLOGICAL SCHEME FOR NEW "EFFECT" SLOT

The scheme shown in the table below contains the following features:

- The scheme combines BENEFICIAL vs. DETRIMENTAL vs. UNSPECIFIED Effect orthagonally with any of three parties affected: SPEAKER, LISTENER, and/or a THIRD-PARTY.
- The consonant-form is to be placed between current Slots II and III of the version 0.3 formative structure.
- The consonant-forms have been selected to allow a following vowel/diphthong, or a following -w- or following -y-.
- For ease-of pronunciation, several of the consonant-forms have allomorphic forms when followed by either -w- and/or -y-, as indicated in the table. When these allomorphic forms are used, the following -w- or -y- is elided.
- SPECIAL NOTE: Formative Slot III currently allows only for Phase or Sanction morphemes beginning with -w- or -y-; however, the scheme below also allows for Slot III to be a simple vowel or diphthong (i.e., without any initial -w- or -y-). Therefore, when using these new Effect forms, it will now be permissible for Slot III to indicate Aspect (using the simple vowel/diphthong forms found in the Aspect table. If Slot III is so used to show Aspect, Slot IV may be optionally used to show a second Aspect.
